Overnight Lane Closures on East Capitol Street Bridge May 7 - 9

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close lanes on the eastbound East Capitol Street Bridge on Tuesday, May 7, through Thursday, May 9, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting.

These overnight closures are needed for the removal of overhead signs and sign structures, part of the Rehabilitation of the East Capitol Street Bridge Project. There will be up to 30-minute traffic stoppages during which the eastbound bridge will be completely closed.

DDOT will provide signage to guide traffic around the work zone and maintain public safety. Motorists should expect delays and are advised to stay alert when traveling through this area.
