Lane Closure on East Capitol Street Bridge April 1 - 18

(Washington DC) The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close the north lane of traffic on the south bridge of the Whitney Young Memorial Bridge (also known as the East Capitol Street Bridge) from Wednesday, April 1 through Saturday, April 18, weather permitting.

One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times.

This closure is necessary to complete work related to the Rehabilitation of the Whitney Young Memorial Bridge Project.

Traffic controls and signage will be in place to safely guide all travelers through the work zone. Motorists should anticipate delays and all travelers are advised to stay alert and use caution when in this area.
